Summary

GEMS provides both interactive dashboards and data reports on the website. The dashboards are utilized when a user intends to engage with and filter the data for specific needs or to answer a particular question. The dashboards provide visualizations that help show patterns and trends in the data. In comparison, the data reports are not interactive in their nature, but provide a comprehensive look into the data report selected. In the case of the student reports, the data provided is detailed student level data. Many users rely on these reports to help answer questions or inform decisions about a school or district. Central Navigation and Knowledge

Each of the data reports are unique in what information they provide, however, accessing is consistent across report type in that you must select the fields in order. Once you have located which report you would like to run, most reports have you begin by selecting the year. For the financial reports this refers to the fiscal year, and for school and district reports this refers either to the school year or the program year. If you attempt to select a field out of order, the dropdown menu for that field will contain no items to select. For example, if you attempt to select the 'County/Legal Entity' field before the 'Fiscal Year' field in the example below, there will be no entity options in its drop-down menu.



Once you have submitted, an SSRS report will appear in the field selection space. From this platform you will have the capability to enter different focus to the fields to submit a new report (1a-c). Most of the reports will be multiple pages in length. You can move between pages by using the toggle arrows (2). Note that if the page number identification displays "2?" this means there are several pages of the report. You can also refresh the page (3), go back to a parent report if applicable (4), and zoom in and out of the report (5). You can also save or export the report in many different formats (6) or print the report as is (7). Lastly, there is a search field (8) you can utilize if looking for a specific item or category within the report.
