




Math and ELA Assessments Dashboard (Grades 3-8)



Summary

The Math and ELA Assessments Dashboard (Grades 3-8) provides data on the Montana state student assessment for mathematics and English language arts in a variety of different ways. Some measures focus on what schools use, proficiency levels in each assessment, other measures focus on measures used in ESSA calculations to rank schools, other measures are for investigating student and school growth on assessments.



Where to Start


Below you will find two guided walk-throughs for accessing specific data to answer a question. These tutorials are provided based on frequently requested data or commonly asked questions on how to view assessment data. This tutorial provides a walkthrough on comparing school-level proficiency to the state for a particular grade.

To view a comparison of proficiency to state proficiency:

Begin by selecting the Students At Or Above Proficiency page of the dashboard (1). Using the *Select County/District/School* filter within the dashboard environment, select the school location(s) of interest (2). This tutorial looks at Bozeman Elementary data for an example.



Using the *Select Grade Level* filter within the dashboard environment, select the grade level(s) of interest (3). The yellow line in the graph provides the trend of statewide percentage of students at or above proficient. The blue line provides the trend the selected school location(s) percentage of students at or above proficient.



Tips and Tricks

- An “*” indicates that the count of students is 10 or less and has been masked. When a chart or graph does not display data, either the data has been masked or no data has been reported for that selection.
- You can click on the down arrow in the top panel to view several demographic slicers like gender, race, or special education participation.
